
## Performance Notes

### Flute:



\*Air Beatboxing - Essentially "talking" into the flute, air beatboxing utilizes the use of talking syllables into the mouthpiece to produce a percussive, breathy series of sounds on the indicated pitches. There is usually expected to be more air than pitch.

"ku" = koo



\*A pitchless, steady stream of air blown through the instrument.

\*Jet Whistle - a very loud glissando like sound produced by sealing the embouchure hole completely with the lips and blowing a fast, high pressure air stream through the flute.
